Ninety-three percent of our students reached their math fact goal. I am so proud of the hard work these students did in achieving their goal.

AHCS will continue to work hard to reach and keep the math goal of having 80% of our students proficient in their math facts. Each grade is focusing on specific facts that align to our state standards:

- Kindergarten: Identifying the numbers 1-20
- 1st Grade- Addition Facts up to 10
- 2nd Grade- Addition and Subtraction Facts 1-10
- 3rd Grade- Addition and Subtraction Facts 1- 20
- 4th Grade- Multiplication and Division Facts 0-10
- 5th and 6th Grade- Multiplying and Dividing 0-12

Please help us reach this goal by practicing math facts with your student at home and reinforcing previous skills from earlier grade levels.

Writing

This school year, we will begin to focus on the academic area of writing. Our goal is to help students develop their writing skills in the areas of organization and sources.
