Tops

Tops must be in solid school approved colors: Flag Red, Navy Blue, White (or off-white), or Black with a **COLLAR**.

Examples: Polos, blouses, button-down dress shirts, peter-pan collars, turtlenecks (regular or mock) including high neck ruffle collars. Sleeves may be long or short. Note: other types of shirts and sweaters may be worn in approved school colors as long as a collared shirt is worn underneath and is not on the restricted list.



Sweaters

Sweater/sweater vests: must be in solid school approved colors for tops. (No sweatshirt fabrics)

Shoes & Belts



Black, Brown, White, Tan, Gray, Navy belts are permitted.
Belts must be worn with pants that have belt loops.



Shoes: Black, Brown, White, Tan, Navy, Gray or Red. 2-tone permitted in school colors. No flip-flops. Sandals must have a back strap.

Students with P.E. **MUST have gym shoes to participate**.

Bottoms

Pants * Shorts * Skirts * Dresses * Jumpers

Approved colors are: Flag Red, Navy Blue, Charcoal Grey, Black and Khaki and White.*Skirts and jumpers may include the Classic Large Navy plaid.*
Bottoms may have a **small** stripe or print in school approved colors.



Note: Shorts and skirts should be No more than 3" above the knee.

(No denim athletic or cargo style pants)



Dress Code NO'S

- No hoodies or sweatshirts
- No denim/jeans
- No earrings for boys
- No facial piercings or tattoos that show.
- No tight, faded, torn or stylized pants
- No patterns on shoes, light-up shoes, neon shoelaces.
- Sequins, glitter, rhinestones

Socks & Accessories



Socks, Tights & Leggings: Colors: Red, White, Tan, Navy, Black, Brown or Gray. Leggings can only be worn under a dress or skirt.

Accessories for hair or scarf, or ties: Any pattern of Navy, Red, White. Earrings: White, black red, blue, gold, silver, titanium, clear, or pearl.

Outerwear Coats, boots, gloves and hats can be ANY color but must be removed once inside the school. **Students should wear a school approved sweater in class if needed.**
